

THE JOHN JENNE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR COMMUNITY SERVICE

Beginning with the May 2009 East Mountain High School Graduation Ceremony, a *John Jenne Memorial Scholarship for Community Service* has been granted annually to a graduating EMHS senior. The applicant for this scholarship must present:

- a cumulative 3.0 grade-point-average,
- evidence of a passion for community service, and
- evidence of a desire to develop this passion later in life.

The scholarship recipient shall be a graduating senior of EMHS, accepted to either a 4-year accredited college or university. The beneficiaries of the \$1,000 *John Jenne Memorial Scholarship* may use the scholarship in support of his/her educational expenses. The scholarship does not have to be paid back; however, the recipients are encouraged to donate to the scholarship fund when they have graduated from college or have begun their career in order that other students can benefit. In this way, the fund remains in existence for as long as possible.

The John Jenne Scholarship Committee will select the recipients of this award based on the quality of this application as well as a personal interview with each applicant. The committee will include an active member of the local chapter of the Great Decisions international relations study group and EMHS representatives.

A resident of Sandia Park, NM, Dr. John Jenne was a physician and a chemist; a person who cared deeply for the welfare of people; a gentleman greatly concerned with issues of justice both locally and globally; and one who acted on his beliefs in a non-intrusive manner.

All applications are due to the John Jenne Scholarship Committee in care of the EMHS Assistant Principal on or before 4:00pm on Thursday, April 28, 2022.
